The parish of **AMBLECOTE** was in 1843 formed from a part of **OLD SWINFORD, WORCS.**

Description of Church (Holy Trinity)

The church, in Vicarage Road, was built 1841-4 (largely at the expense of XXXXX) to designs by *Samuel Heming (CPDD)* and consecrated 1844.
